- More to Prophecy - 1:19

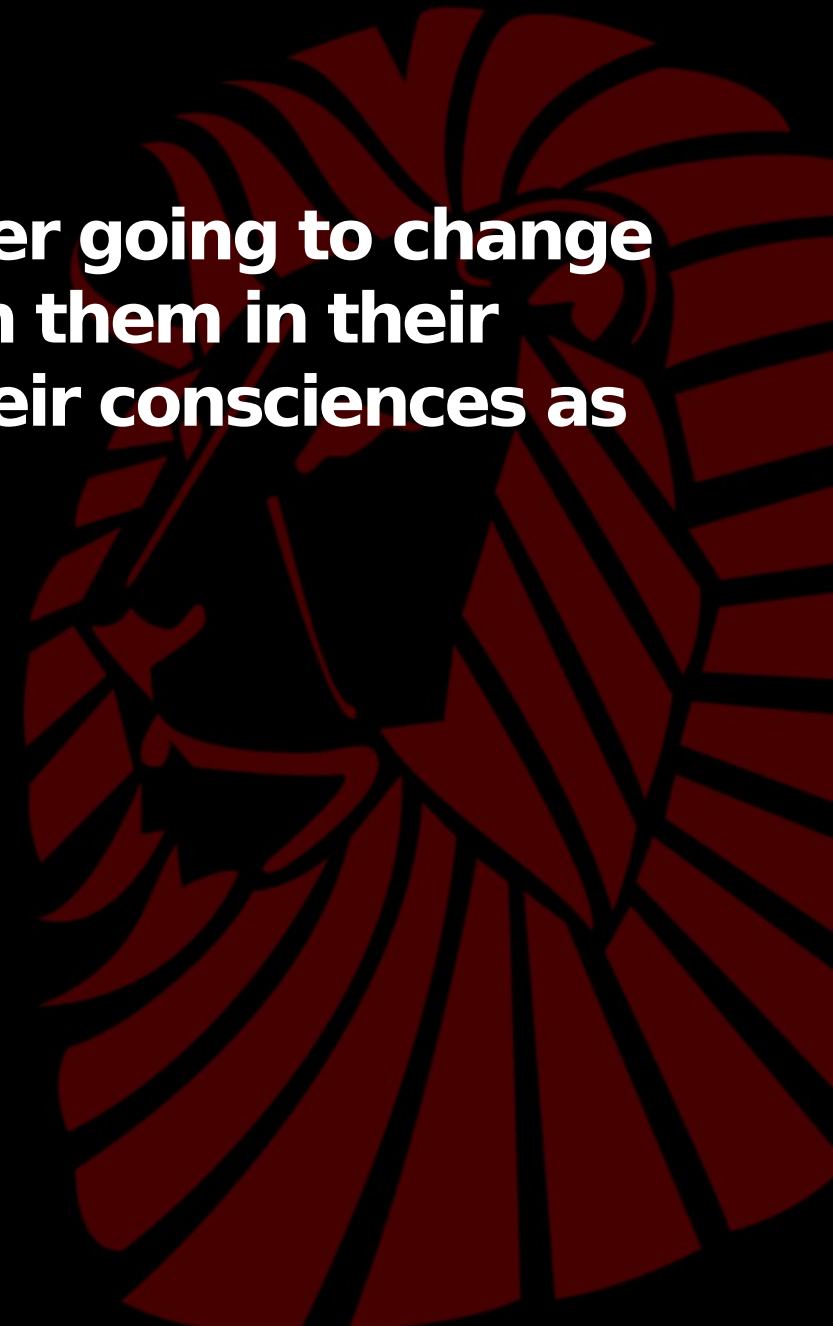
