- 2. Christ's self-description from Son of Man vision
- 3. Commendation of the church's good works
- 4. Accusation because of some sin,
- 5. Exhortation to repent with a warning
- 6. Exhortation to discern the truth
- 7. Promise to the conquerors.

- Strategic city in Asia Minor
- Strong in endurance and against false teaching
- Weak in love to God and to each other

# Smyrna

- Only one of 7 cities still in existence (Izmir)
- Son of Man first/last; dead/alive
- Great persecutions
- Be Faithful

# Pergamum

- Capital city of Asia Minor
- Son of Man Two edged Sword
- Remained Faithful
- Allowed false teachers

# Special Notes of 7 Churches: Thyatira

- City for manufacturing and market
- Son of Man Eyes of fire feet of bronze
- Strong works love, faith, service, patience
- Given over to spiritual adultery Jezebel

- City of decline held to ancient prestige
- Son of Man has seven stars
- Reputation Alive; Truth Dead
- Be watchful and wake up!

# Special Notes of 7 Churches: Philadelphia

- City of prosperity gateway to the East
- Son of Man Holy One, True One
- Nothing said against them
- Kept His Word, Endured

- City of wealth

- Not Hot or Cold
- Did not understand their condition
